Dear Parents & Carers,

Share & Shine – we hope you enjoyed this opportunity to visit your child's classroom and see some of what they've been learning so far this year. The children love these occasions and we really appreciate your support in attending them, we had an amazing **90** visitors, which is fantastic!

Attendance Matters - There are incredibly strong links between the attendance figures of children and their attainment which is why there will be further requirements on schools to monitor and report attendance next year. Research shows that higher than average rates of attendance lead to more secure outcomes for pupils. We monitor every child's attendance at least weekly and will discuss this with parents where we have concerns and involve our Local Authority Attendance officer where necessary.

Reading - As a school, we champion reading for pleasure and we expect children of all ages to be reading outside of school and ask that notes are made in the home/school reading record that we provide. Even where children are reading fluently and independently it is important that children are encouraged to read regularly at home to keep this vital skill continuously developing as this impacts learning in all areas of the curriculum. Thank you for supporting your child with this fundamental life skill.

Homework - In addition to the core homework for each class: reading, spelling, number fact learning, each term we offer a menu of optional homework that can be completed by children across the school. This term I have asked children for their ideas for what they would like to see on the homework menu and this is being finalised and will be sent out next week.

Parents meetings - We have had great take-up for our parents meeting with teachers next week. If you find you are not able to attend your appointment, please do cancel in good time as this will enable teachers to offer the time to someone else and will avoid valuable teacher time being wasted – thank you.

Nail varnish & temporary tattoos: These are not allowed as part of our uniform and appearance policy, please save them for holiday periods – thank you.
