Message from Mrs Talbot:

We have had a great week, but the highlight has to have been World Book Day. Children and staff all entered in to the spirit of the day and costumes were fabulous - thank you for your efforts and supporting us in this.

Huge thanks to FOBS and wonderful parent helpers who made last Friday's Neon Disco such a success, we had a fabulous turnout with 70% of children taking part. Building works:

As you, know we have some building works in the pipeline for some time now, with the mobile to be replaced with a permanent building and some minor remodelling to the main school. We are at the stage where we will start to see things happening on site. The existing mobile is due to be removed from site over the Easter holidays to then allow significant ground works to take place before the new building can take shape, this always takes much longer than we might think.

Both Key Stage 2 classes will need to be re-located whilst the build, which is anticipated to take 6 months, takes place. Owls class will move in to our spare classroom in the main building and Swans class, who need a bit more space, will utilise the canteen building which will be set up as their classroom with all their furniture, interactive whiteboard, displays etc. The canteen will still be used for hot school dinners as normal. The minor re-modelling of the main building, mainly toilets, will take place during the Summer holidays whilst children are not on site.

This is an exciting time for Benwick Primary School, however all building works come with an element of disruption to normal routine. We think this current plan for the Key Stage 2 classes will keep things as normal as possible for them until the new classrooms are ready in late Autumn. Once groundworks start, access for contractors to the site will be through the field gate and the building site will be fenced off from the playground and main school for children's safety.

We will let you know of any other changes and plans as they evolve.
