Children's Mental Health Week

Children's Mental Health week starts on Monday 5th February and we will be marking this with an assembly and the children will also be undertaking some fun and helpful lessons all about having good mental health.

Attached are some top tips for helping you speak to your children about mental health. It doesn't need to be a 'one off' conversation, a simple chat about how your child's day was walking or driving home or when you are all sitting down for dinner at night can be enough and most importantly don't forget to listen!

Measles Outbreak and MMR Vaccinations

Attached is a letter from the Director of Public Health in relation to the measles outbreak across the West Midlands and how we can hopefully avoid it in Cambridgeshire.

Two doses of the MMR vaccination give long-lasting protection against measles, mumps and rubella. Now is a good time to check that your child is up to date with their MMR vaccinations. You can do this by looking at their personal health record (Red Book) or by asking your GP. Children who have missed their routine MMR vaccination can catch up at any age so please book an appointment at your GP as soon as possible. You can request a version of the MMR vaccine that does not contain pork products from your GP, making it suitable for all faiths.

The Community and School Age Immunisation Service is running walk-in vaccination clinics for children who are not up to date with their MMR vaccinations. Details of upcoming clinics can be found here: https://www.cpics.org.uk/measles. There is a clinic taking place at Doddington Hospital on Monday 19th February 9am-5pm so if you child hasn't had their MMR vaccinations then please do make an appointment with them, especially if you cannot get into your GP surgery.

Measles symptoms to be aware of include:

- High temperature
- Cough
- Sore, red, watery eyes
- A blotchy red brown rash, which usually appears after the initial symptoms
- Spots in the mouth

Film Night:

Funds raised will be for our enrichment fund (this is what we used for Panto). The cost will be \pounds 3 and children will receive squash or water, popcorn and biscuits.
