Message from Mrs Talbot:

New Reception Parents Evening:

Building progress:

Free School Meals

Children in Reception, Yr1 and Yr2 all receive universal free school meals. If however you receive any of the following benefits your child may also be entitled to benefit related free school meals.

The economic criteria are:

- * Income Support
- * Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- * Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- * Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- * The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- * Child Tax Credit (unless you're also entitled to Working Tax Credit, and earn no more than £16,190)
- * Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop receiving Working Tax Credit)
- * Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400)

Even if you do not think you would qualify at this point, once you have completed the form, the free school meal team will be able to continue to check eligibility throughout your child's school years using the ECS checking system. You will be notified if you become eligible in the future.
