



Benwick Primary School – Autumn Term Curriculum Map for Owls Class



<p>English: We will begin our English learning with a short unit of poetry looking at Haikus and Cinquains, analysing poetry and using imagery including onomatopoeia to engage the senses of the reader. We will then move on to persuasive writing through advertisements looking at the use of superlatives, slogans and rhetorical questions, before finally looking at first person diary entries.</p> <p>In guided reading we will be looking at works by Dick King-Smith and Nizrana Farook as well as a non-fiction text to coincide with Black History month.</p>	<p>Maths: We will be revisiting our place value learning from previous years and extending our understanding.</p> <p>In year 3 we will be looking at representing and partitioning numbers to 100 and 1000, using and estimating on a number line to 100 and 1000, comparing and ordering numbers to 100 and 1000 and counting in 50s.</p> <p>In year 4 we will be looking at numbers up to 10,000, partitioning them, estimating on a number line and 10, 100 or 1000 more or less, rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100 or 1000, ordering numbers up to 10,000 and Roman numerals.</p>	<p>Science: Our science this term will be looking at rocks and how different types of rock are formed. We will learn about fossils and how soil is formed of rocks and other matter. In the second of half of term we will be learning about animals including humans, looking into the human digestive system and the different types and roles of our teeth.</p>
<p>RE: We will be looking at Christianity and how and why churches are different, learning about the various parts of the church building and their significance to Christians. We will also be asking what moral guidance sacred texts provide.</p>	<p>PSHE: We will be following the Cambridgeshire PSHE curriculum module entitled <i>Myself and my relationships – Family and Friendship</i>. We will be learning about the types of relationships we have within our friendship groups and family.</p>	<p>PE/Games: One lesson of PE each week will be taught by the sports coach. This term Mr Kirby will be teaching football and hockey. Mrs Clutton will be teaching ball skills and dance. Our PE days will be Thursday and Friday</p>
<p>Computing: We will be revisiting our online safety learning before moving on to spreadsheets, graphing and simulations.</p>	<p>French: In French we will learn how to get to know someone by learning how to greet them and ask basic questions. We will then learn how to tell someone about ourselves.</p>	<p>Music: We will explore the instruments, stylistic features and rhythms of Bhangra music, developing our knowledge and understanding of standard notation through performing and notating rhythms using crotchets, paired quavers and crotchet rests.</p>



Art/DT: In art we will be drawing still life pictures, using the work of Morandi as inspiration, focusing on lines and detail and using a viewfinder to select a focal point. We will then move on to painting comparing the work of two abstract artists examining in detail a part of a flower using magnifiers and viewfinders before sketching and then enlarging it. In DT we will be looking at the difference between processed foods and fresh food making healthy pizza, fresh bread and soup. We will then move on to look at mechanisms including hinges to answer the question “how many ways are there to open a door?”

History/Geography: In history we will be learning about the Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age finding out about culture, lifestyle, technology, travel and religion.

In geography we will be exploring human and physical features of Benwick and using the compass and maps to navigate around an area. We will also be comparing, using an OS map, different areas of the country.
