Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to the Spring Term in Owls Class. We hope you all had a lovely Christmas and New Year break. We are all really looking forward to another term with your children and have lots more exciting learning lined up!

It has been lovely to welcome your children into our brand-new classroom, and we have spoken at length about applying our school values of responsibility, community and respect to looking after the building to maintain its beautiful condition.

Please help your child make the best start to the new school term by ensuring they have all the things they need each day, including correct uniform and a water bottle, all of which should be **clearly named**. Children should not bring in any toys, including teddies or balls, from home.

Snacks:

Breaktime snacks are encouraged, these should be healthy, for example fruit or plain cereal bars. Chocolate bars, biscuits, cakes, crisps, sweets including peppermints are not allowed. Please remember we are a **nut free school** due to children with serious allergies.

Reading book arrangements: These will continue as for last term. Please do encourage your child to read at home so they can quiz at school and work towards their target. Once they achieve their target, they will receive a certificate. We will also continue to give out certificates for reading five times a week.

Children will continue to access the library from where their choices will be scanned out so that they can borrow beautiful books to share with you at home. It is important that these books are returned and scanned back into the library. Any outstanding books will be followed up by letter prior to fines being issued

PE arrangements:

Our class PE/Games sessions remain on Thursdays and Fridays. Please make sure children have their **named** PE kit in school for these days – this should be a white t-shirt



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and black shorts/leggings, with tracksuit bottoms in cooler weather and trainers. Football strips and multi-coloured t-shirts and shorts are not permitted.

Homework expectations:

Our basic homework expectations for children are:

Daily reading - minimum of 15 minutes – please record when you have heard them read in their reading record.

Spelling – spellings are given out on a Friday and are tested the following Friday. Please help your child to learn these at home, little and often is best.

Times tables/Counting - All children have login details to access TT Rockstars. However, oral counting, chanting and testing of number facts works best, so the children have rapid recall of these facts which greatly improves their ability to access mathematics across the curriculum – number games in the supermarket can be fun or on car journeys can be a useful way to pass the time.
