#### Snacks:

**Reading book arrangements:** Children should choose a levelled reading book from their range and change this as required, quizzing after each book. They also have access to the library from where they can choose up to two books for reading for pleasure, these will be scanned out using our library system. It is important that these books are returned and scanned back into the library, any outstanding books will be followed up by letter.

## PE arrangements:

Our class PE/Games sessions are on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons. Tuesdays will be handball with Mrs Nicholson-Smith and Thursdays gymnastics with the sports coach. Please make sure your child has their named PE kit in school all week –



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this should be a white t-shirt and black shorts/leggings, with tracksuit bottoms in cooler weather and trainers. Football strips and multi-coloured t-shirts and shorts are not allowed, thank you.

### Homework expectations:

Our basic homework expectations for children are:

Daily reading - minimum of 20 minutes – please record when you have heard them read in their reading record

Spelling – spellings are given out on Monday and are tested on the following Monday. Please help your child to learn these at home, little and often is best.

Times tables/Counting - All children will be given login details to access Timetable Rockstars.
