Wellbeing

A new local mental health free text messaging support service is launching across Cambridgeshire and Peterborough on Monday 13 November. HEAR 85258 is being funded by NHS Cambridgeshire & Peterborough, in partnership with the national service SHOUT. The free to use text service provides real-time support to people who are struggling with their mental health across the county. When texting the word HEAR to 85258, the person will be connected to a trained volunteer who will offer them calm in a time or place of crisis. During the confidential and anonymous conversation, the texter will be supported while working on a plan of action and signposted to local and national mental health services. Texting HEAR to 85258 is free, discreet and runs 24/7. It won't appear on a mobile bill and requires no app, data, password, or registration.

Attendance

There are incredibly strong links between the attendance figures of children and their attainment. Research shows that higher than average rates of attendance lead to more secure outcomes for pupils. We monitor every child's attendance at least weekly and will discuss this with parents where we have concerns and involve our Local Authority Attendance officer where necessary.

We had a really good start to the new school year, however we are now starting to see children's attendance dropping. If your child is poorly please call the school office before 9am and leave a message on the absence line or alternatively email office@benwick.cambs.sch.uk. Please let us know the exact nature of the illness, we cannot accept 'feeling poorly'.

Routine medical appointments must be outside of school hours, including travelling time. If your child has to attend a hospital appointment we do expect them to attend school before/after the appointment. You will need to complete a Leave of absence form which are available from the school office and we will need to see a copy of the hospital letter/text/email.

Term time holidays cannot be authorised, however if you are taking your child on a term time holiday please complete a leave of absence form and be honest with us. Any parent who takes a child out of school for term time leave for 3 days or more, may receive a Penalty Notice. If 3 or more term time leave Penalty Notices have been issued over a 3 year period then prosecution may be considered by the local authority.

Safeguarding

Safeguarding is the action taken to promote the welfare of children and protect them from harm. Safeguarding means protecting children from abuse and maltreatment, preventing harm to children's health or development and ensuring children grow up with the provision of safe and effective care.
